WHAT IS MOVE?

MOVE is a 5-day summer event designed for high school students to know Jesus better, deepen their relationships, and to be sent out to do Kingdom Work.

When and Where: July 1-6, 2024 @ Lee University in Cleveland, TN.

- We will travel to Tennessee in charter buses, provided by the church.
- We will be sleeping in the dorms on campus. Beds will be provided, but students will need to bring their own bedding. (sleeping bag + pillow or twin sheets, etc.)
- We will do our best to accommodate roommate requests.

WHAT WILL WE DO?

- There will be large-group worship and teaching experiences by CIY.
- There will be time together in small groups and in our church groups.
- There will be time together to relax and have fun participating in many different recreation opportunities, including time either rafting or zip-lining on Thursday.

WHAT DOES CIY COST?

The cost for students to attend CIY with Highland Church of Christ is \$525. This cost includes CIY's registration cost (programming, meals, and lodging), a t-shirt, rafting or zip-lining, and other trip expenses. The cost of transportation is covered by the church.

- Registration opens on October 1 and will close at the end of the month.
- Spots may be available after registration closes, but we cannot guarantee an opening.

PARTICIPANT RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, I fully understand and acknowledge that outdoor recreational activities has: (a) inherent risks, dangers and hazards and such exists in my use of Raft 1 Co. equipment and my participation in outdoor related activities; (b) my participation in such activities and/or use of such equipment may result in injury or illness including, but not limited to, bodily injury, disease, strains, fractures, partial and/or total paralysis, death or other ailments that could cause serious disability; (c) that these risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the owners, employees, officers or agents of Raft 1 Co.; the negligence of the participants, the negligence of others, accidents, breaches of contract, the forces of nature or other causes. Risks and dangers may arise from foreseeable or unforeseen causes including, but not limited to, guide decision making, including that a guide may misjudge terrain, weather, trail or river route location, and water level, risks of falling out of or drowning while in or out of a raft, canoe or a kayak and such other risks, hazards and dangers that are integral to recreational activities that take place in a wilderness, outdoor or recreational environment; and (d) by my participation in these activities and for use of the equipment, I hereby assume all risks and dangers and all responsibility for my losses and/or damages, whether caused in whole or in part by the negligence or other conduct of the owners, agents, officers, or employees of Raft 1 Co. or by any other person.

Inherent and Other Risks: Serious injuries are uncommon in Canopy Tours and Mountain Biking, but the risk of injury or death certainly exists by reason of falls, contact with other participants, and fixed objects moving about or being transported on the grounds on which these activities are initiated and conducted. A number of risks are inherent to these activities. These are risks that cannot be eliminated without changing the essential nature of the experience. The emotional risks range from unwelcome or inadvertent touching, simple hurt feelings to panic and psychological trauma (such as fear of heights.) The physical risks of participating range from small scrapes and bruises to bites and stings, broken bones, sprains, neurological damage and, in extraordinary cases, even death. The property on which the tour is conducted includes hilly, rocky and wooded terrain, cliffs, ravines, creek beds, potential harmful plants and animals, which may bite or sting. Injuries may be a natural consequence of the Canopy Tour or trail undertaken as a result of the environmental hazards (including terrain and weather), a result of errors in judgment or failure to exercise reasonable care by guides, staff or participants, or otherwise, and may occur in spite of the reasonable efforts of guides and staff to prevent them. In all cases, those inherent risks, as well as other risks of injury or death to persons or damage to property, which are not inherent and whether or not described above, must be accepted by those who choose to participate. In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the program, related events and activities, I, the undersigned, acknowledge, appreciate and agree that:

1. The risk of injury from the activities involved in this program is significant, including but not limited to the potential for permanent paralysis and death.
2. **I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS**, both known and unknown, **EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES** or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation.
3. I willingly agree to comply with terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately.
4. By participating in or attending any activity in connection with this program, whether on or off the premises, I consent o the use of any photographs, pictures, file or videotape taken of me or provided by me for publicity, promotion, television, websites or any other use, and expressly waive any right of privacy, compensation, copyright or other ownership right connected to same.
5. I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, **HEREBY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS** The Raft 1 Co., its officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsors, advertisers, the state of Tennessee, the United States of America, Ocoee River Outfitters Association and the Tennessee Valley Authority and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event, from any and all claims, demands, losses, and liability arising out of or related to any **INJURY, DISABILITY OR DEATH** I may suffer, or loss or damage to person or property, **WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE**, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
6. The parties agree that the laws of the State of Tennessee shall apply to any dispute that may arise out of this Agreement. The venue of any dispute that may arise out of this Agreement or otherwise between the parties to which Raft 1 Co. or its agents is a party, shall be in the Hamilton County Court for the State of Tennessee.
