

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

WHAT IS MOVE?

- We will be sleeping in the dorms on campus. Beds will be provided, but students will
 need to bring their own bedding. (sleeping bag + pillow or twin sheets, etc.)
- We will do our best to accommodate roomate requests.

WHAT WILL WE DO?

- There will be large-group worship and teaching experiences by CIY.
- There will be time together in small groups and in our church groups.
- There will be time together to relax and have fun participating in many different recreation opportunities, including time either rafting or zip-lining on Thursday.

WHAT DOES CIY COST?

The cost for students to attend CIY with Highland Church of Christ is \$525. This cost includes CIY's registration cost (programming, meals, and lodging), a t-shirt, rafting or ziplining, and other trip expenses. The cost of transportation is covered by the church.

- Registration opens on October 1 and will close at the end of the month.
- Spots may be available after registration closes, but we cannot guarantee an opening.
